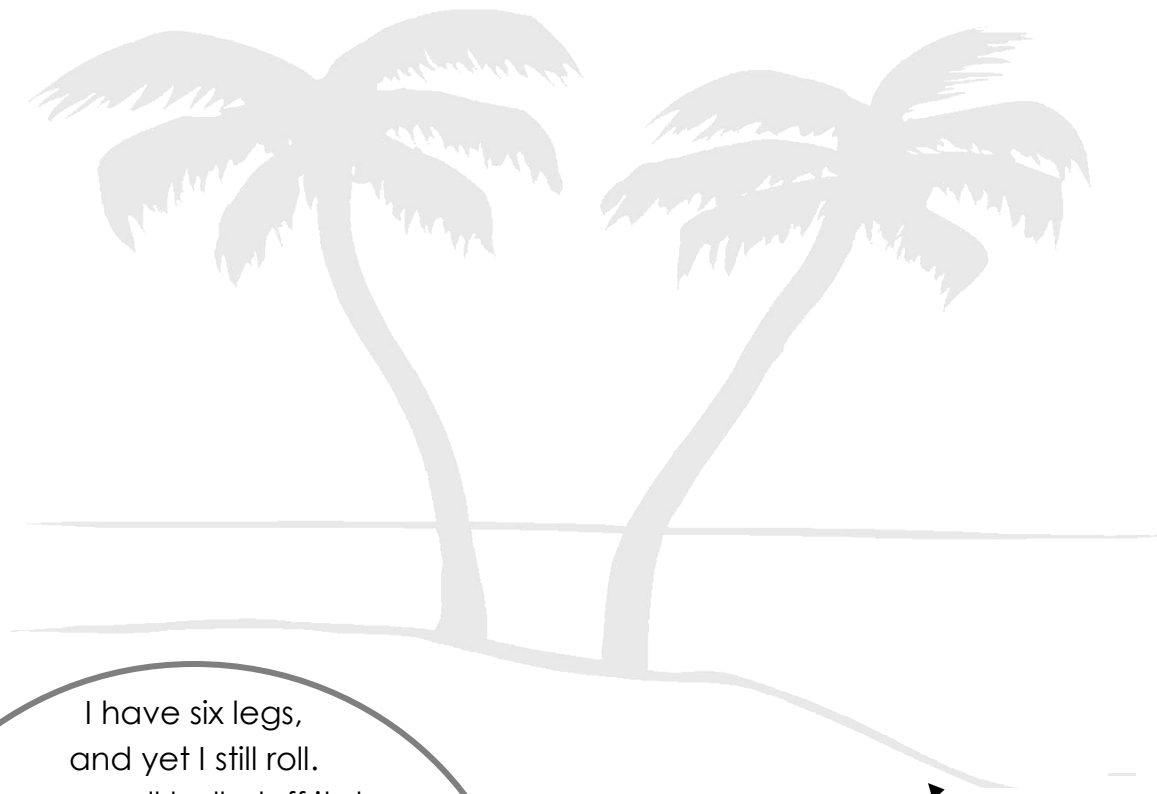


Desert Riddle
