

Scripture Poster Project - Uganda

Five-Day Schedule



We understand that Children's ministry schedules keep you busy! If you would like to spread the *Scripture Poster Project* lessons out over five shorter sessions, this schedule may work for you. Each session lasts approximately 30 minutes. They could serve as a supplement to your daily vacation Bible school program.

Day 1

- "Introducing Uganda" lesson with PowerPoint slide show followed by the review "game"
- "Send the Word - Uganda Part A" (leaving the thank you letter for Day 5)
- Show a sample laminated poster with a string / yarn hanger to build anticipation.

Day 2

- "The Locked Bible"
- "I Can Read Shape Script"
- Begin coloring posters. The posters are found in "Send the Word - Uganda Part B."

Day 3

- "Literacy Changes Lives"
- Continue coloring posters.

Day 4

- "Iwana Read Puppet Script"
- "Literacy for Life"
- While some children put the finishing touches on their posters, those who have already finished their posters can enjoy coloring the "Literacy for Life" coloring booklet.

Day 5

- Review what the children have learned about Uganda and about the need for literacy.
- Perhaps the children can add the string / yarn hangers to their posters and pose with them for pictures before putting them in the prepared mailer to send to Uganda.
- Read the "Thank You Letter" found at the end of "Send the Word - Uganda Part A" or prepare a copy for each child to take home to share with their family.
- If you will have a closing program for your daily vacation Bible school, perhaps some older children would enjoy presenting the "Iwana Read Puppet Script."

Day 4 (optional)

(If possible, try to back the completed posters onto colored construction paper, laminate them, and punch holes for the string / yarn hangers so that the children can see the "finished products" on Day 5. Address one or more padded mailers to the Uganda address given.)
