

Uganda Scripture Poster Project

*I*n July 2008, Timothy, the Bwisi Scripture Use Coordinator, delivered posters with Scripture printed on them to the Bwisi school in Bundibugyo, Uganda. What's so special about these posters? They were colored by children nearly halfway around the world—4th graders from Calvary Church in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, to be exact.

*T*he 4th graders colored Scripture posters that had been printed in the Bwisi language, and each student attached a picture of themselves to the back of the posters they colored. Then Wycliffe staff made sure the posters got into Timothy's hands so he could bring them to the Bwisi children himself.

Fourth graders from Pennsylvania make a difference for Bwisi school children!

*T*he Bwisi students, who had just completed their first Bwisi literacy class, were thrilled to receive the posters! As they read Scripture verses from the posters out loud to their classmates, the other students listened intently. This inspired all the Bwisi children to learn to read in their own language. Afterward the children hung the posters in their homes, prompting discussion about spiritual issues with family and neighbors. Timothy encouraged the children to keep reading the posters and Bwisi language books until they could read and write fluently.

*A*ll the children wanted to read and have a Scripture poster of their own—in fact, they begged to receive more! The school is now asking for more posters to be sent. “May God bless all those who have been involved in making the Bible posters,” Timothy says. “It's only too bad that there are so few.”
