Deciding Where to Go

All modules from Lesson 3—Deciding Where to Go

(Note: Session 4, as written, will only work for a group of about 15 or fewer. For larger audiences, you can also divide into smaller groups with a map and several airplanes for each group and an adult to guide each group.)

Translating the Bible

- Session 1 Lesson 5—Create an Alphabet
“Activity Page” module
- Session 2 Lesson 6—Write a Draft
Combine “Scripture Discussion” and “Translation Example” modules
- Session 3 Lesson 8—Revise the Draft
Combine “Scripture Discussion” module (skip references to scribe activities) and “Activity Page” modules
- Session 4 Lesson 10—Make Final Changes
Combine “Experiencing the Need” and “Matching Game” modules. Play the matching game together using an overhead projector and a transparency of page 6.
- Session 5 Lesson 12—Celebrate Together
Read Scripture from “Scripture Discussion” module and play “Life Without the Bible” clip or “Aukan Dedication” clip from the resource CD.

“Activity Page” module, read the verses to the children and work through the page together. You may only want to read one verse for each topic.
- Session 5 Lesson 9—Use God’s Word
“Story” module
