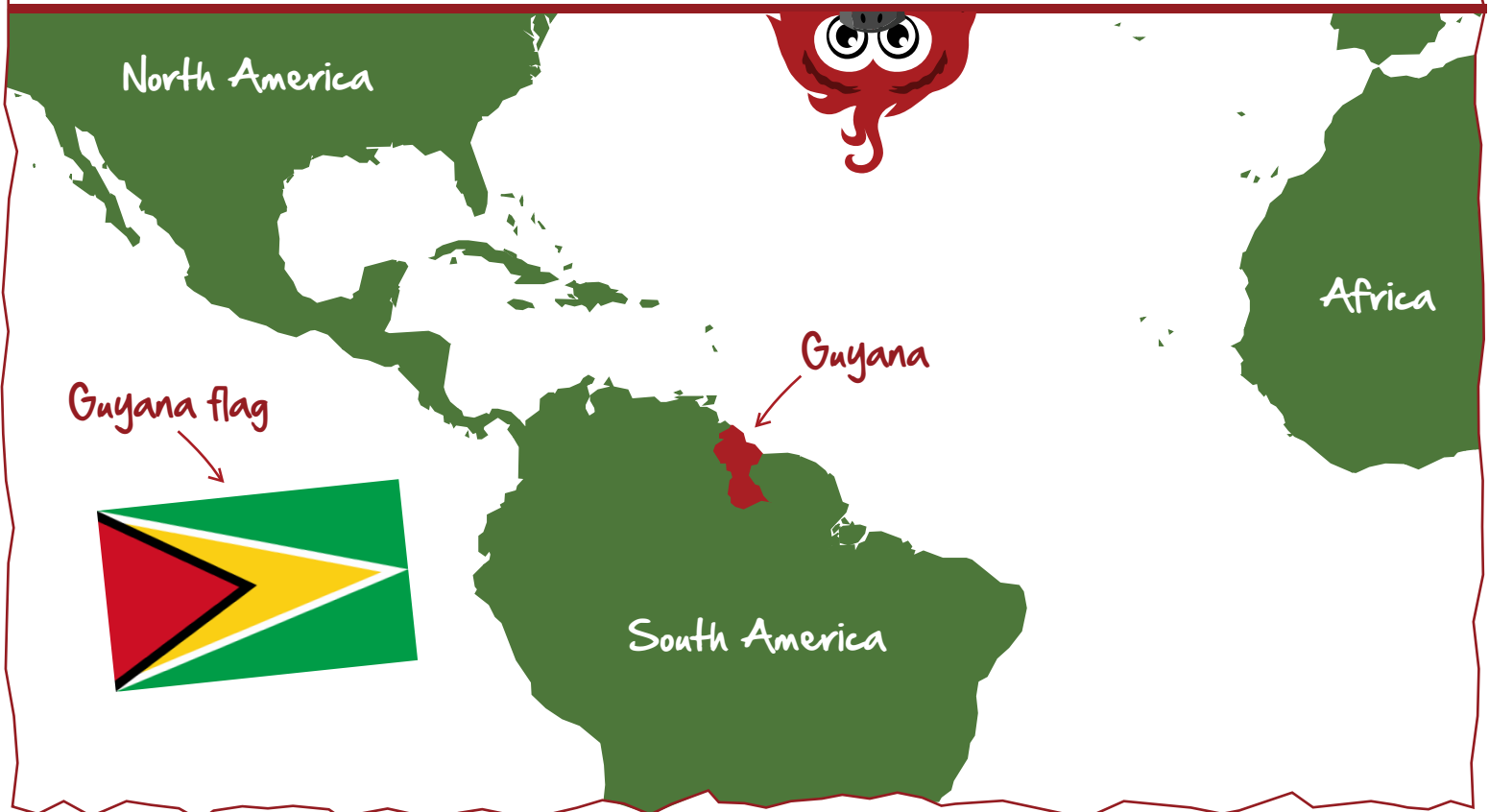


Let's Go Fly an Easter Kite!

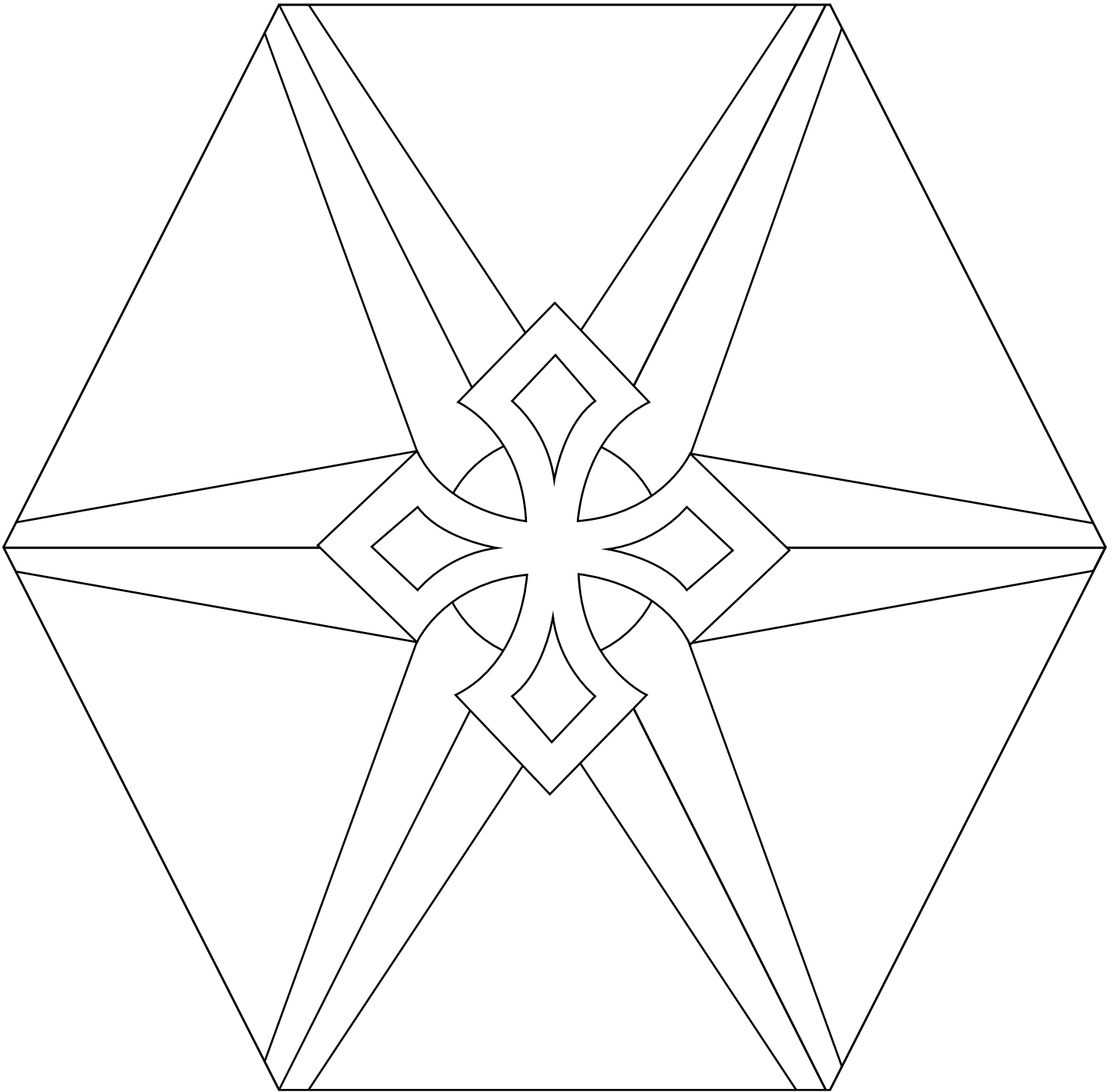

The kites are made of all different sizes, patterns and colors, and in Guyana you'll see lots of kites flying around — especially on Easter Monday.

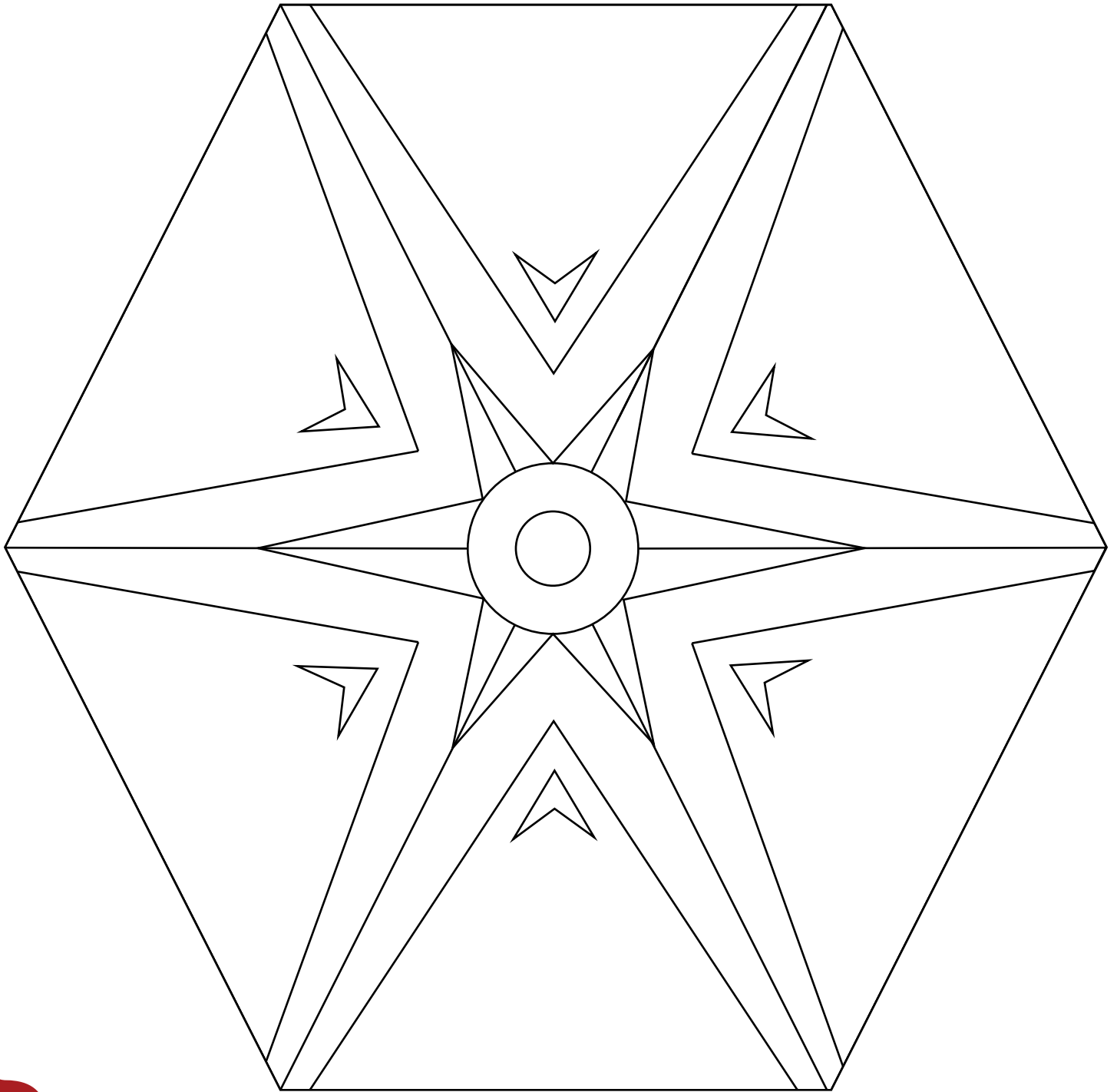
